SKILLING/UPSKILLING TRAINING PROGRAMS BY CSIR

CSIR-Human Resource Development Centre signs MoUs with four Sector Skill

The MoUs are envisaged to strengthen the skill ecosystem in the country

CSIR launched a national-level unique Program "CSIR Integrated Skill Initiative" in 2016 to equip young minds with the necessary technological skills through et CSIR laboratories and address the critical needs for the technical gap created by the enormous usage of advanced technology.

Beneficiaries from this initiative includes school dropouts, farmers, ITT diploma holden, graduates and doctorates. CSER has so far trained over 1.50 labh indi-this lontaries, through 4500-4 dipl-based trainings, including special programs for rural critizens and women. आईडीटीआर जमशेदपुर में दो जॉब के लिए प्रशिक्षण हुआ शुरू

18 पारंपरिक काम को टेनिंग में शामिल किया गया



गम्हरिया | प्रधानमंत्री विश्वकर्मा योजना के तहत आईडीटीआर जमशेदपुर में 2 जॉब रोल का प्रशिक्षण प्रारंभ किया गया। सरायकेला जिला ही नहीं बल्कि पूरे झारखंड में आईडीटीआर पहला संस्थान है जिसमें टोकरी निर्माण एवं कारपेंटर का प्रशिक्षण शुरू किया गया है। इसके तहत पहला दिन बुधवार को दोनों जॉब रोल में चयनित प्रशिक्षुओं को प्रशिक्षण दिया गया। आईडीटीआर के महाप्रबंधक आनंद दयाल ने बताया कि एमएसएमई मंत्रालय भारत सरकार के दिशा निर्देश पर कार्यक्रम की शुरूआत की गई है। इस योजना में कुल 18 प्रकार के पारंपरिक काम शामिल किए गए हैं। जिसमें से दो का प्रशिक्षण आईडीटीआर

में शुरू किया गया है। शीघ्र ही अन्य का प्रशिक्षण भी प्रारंभ किया जाएगा। दयाल ने कहा कि इस योजना के तहत 4 साल की अवधि के लिए 3 लाख रूपए तक का कोलैटरल-फ्री लोन 5 प्रतिशत प्रति वर्ष ब्याज की दर पर देने का प्रावधान किया गया है। प्रशिक्षण की संयोजिका प्रियंका ने बताया कि इस योजना के तहत बेसिक और एडवांस प्रशिक्षण प्रदान की जाती है। उन्होंने बताया कि एमएसडीई की 5-7 दिन की बेसिक प्रशिक्षण को पूरा करने के बाद ही कस्टमर इस योजना के लाभ के तहत पहले चरण में 1 लाख रूपए का लोन प्राप्त कर सकते हैं। दसरे चरण में 2 लाख रूपए का लोन लेने का
