## CSIR IN SKILLING

**CSIR laboratories have been continuously providing training in diverse areas for undergraduates, postgraduates and research students. They are also engaged in conducting Industry oriented training/ skilling programmes that have been well accepted by users. In order to encapsulate all CSIR skill/ training programme under one umbrella that envisages to cater to a diverse cross-section of people at various levels beginning with school dropouts to farmers to ITI diploma holders to graduates, CSIR has launched the programme on 'Integrated Skill Initiative' in year 2016 in line with National Skill Mission.**

**CSIR Human Resource Development Centre, Ghaziabad is performing the nodal responsibility for this programme in coordinating, monitoring, facilitating and implementing the activities among all the participating CSIR laboratories. Till date around 4000 no. of skilling/ reskilling training programmes have been conducted in which around 1,45,000 individuals have been trained.**
